## **Implant Timeline**

Tooth Replacement The implant process begins when a tooth / teeth need to be replaced. This may begin with a referral from your dentist, a need for a tooth extraction, or a pre-existing missing tooth.

Next step: Schedule a consultation with Winchester Oral Surgery Center to evlauate the implant needs.

An implant consultation includes: evaluation of bone, discussion of treatment options, and CBCT (x-ray).

Next step: If not done at consultation, schedule treatment plan appointments. This could include a tooth extraction, a bone graft and/or sinus lift.

Extraction / Bone Graft

Consultation

Our doctors will extract teeth discussed at your consultation. Any necessary bone grafting may be done at this time and will yield a 3-4 month healing process before moving forward with implant placement.

Next step: Schedule follow up appointments.

During this 3 month healing process we will schedule follow ups (~3-4 visits) to evaluate healing. If a guide is needed, models will be taken 3 weeks prior to implant placement.

Next step: Schedule guide models or implant placement.

Our doctors will place the implant(s). This takes 30-60 minutes.

If you are being sedated, it is important to remember to have nothing to eat or drink (including water) 6 hours prior to your appointment.

Next step: Schedule 1st follow up appointment. (See post-op instructions)

Implant Healing Period The average healing period is about 3 months. During this time we will schedule follow ups (~3-4 visits) to ensure that everything is healing properly and the implant is integrating into the bone.

Next step: If needed schedule implant uncovering.

If gum tissue has formed over the implant it will be removed at this appointment. This procedure takes 20-30 minutes.

Uncovering

Next step: Schedule impression appointment with dentist at least one week after uncovering appointment.

There are 2 appointments you will schedule with your general dentist.

- 1. For your dentist to take an impression for your permanent crown.
- 2. For the placement of your permanent crown.

The crown is not included in our cost. Payment will be collected by your general dentist.
